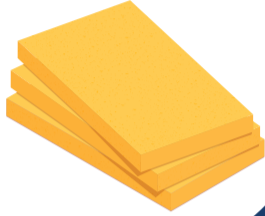


How Weatherization Works

Insulation

New insulation in your attics, walls, or floors keeps heat inside your house in the winter, and outside your house in the summer.



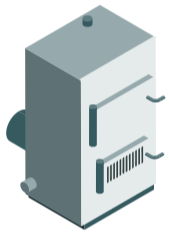
Air Sealing

Sealing holes and cracks in your home prevents indoor drafts and keeps unhealthy outdoor air pollutants out of your home.



Heating & Cooling Repair or Replacement

We can repair or replace broken or old and inefficient furnaces, boilers, air conditioners, and heat pumps.



Water Heater Repair or Replacement

Never run out of hot water again and spend less money by repairing or replacing your water heater.



Lighting Upgrades

New LED light bulbs use less energy, saving you money.



New Smoke & CO Detectors

We also install new smoke and carbon monoxide detectors as part of our weatherization assistance services, to help keep your family safe in the event of a fire or gas leak.
